## Town Council Budget

Although Blandford Forum Town Council's budget for 2012–2013 has been increased in line with inflation, there is no increase to residents' council tax due to the increase in the number of properties within the town. The Town Council will be identifying actions for its new Strategic Plan for 2012–2016. This includes the redevelopment of the Corn Exchange, for which a planning application has been submitted, and the expansion of the cemetery as it is nearing capacity. The £50,000 contribution to Blandford Leisure Centre will continue and £22,000 has been set aside for grants to local organisations. Throughout the year the Town Council will continue to manage its venues, facilities and services provided for the residents of Blandford Forum and visitors to the town.



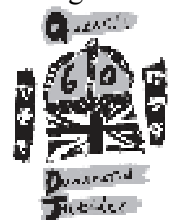
## Police Number for Non-Emergencies

101 is the number to call when you want to contact your local police when it is less urgent than 999. It is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Call 101 to contact the police to report less urgent crime and disorder or to speak to your local officers. For example, call 101 if your car has been stolen, your property has been damaged, if you suspect drug use or dealing in your local area, to report a minor traffic accident, to give the police information about crime in your area, or to speak to the police about a general enquiry. If you have a non-emergency problem to report but cannot call 101, you can contact your local police force on their alternative non-emergency number (01202 222222).
